### **DESCRIPTION**

SA State Figure Skating Championships are conducted for Ladies and Men in Singles and Pairs from Primary to Senior and Synchronized Team Skating for Novice, Junior, Senior and Adult levels.

Winter Challenge is an annual Interstate Competition for Ladies and Men, Aussie Skate to Pre-Primary and all levels of Solo Dance, and Adult Free Skating Singles. Also offered is Synchronized Skating at Aussie Skate and Open levels. The Competition is conducted under the rules of the ISA. A division called 'Youth' is available by request; the technical requirements are the same as ISA Adult, and age requirement is 13 - 17 years. Pre-Preliminary will also be available on request.

## WITHDRAWALS:

Refund – only with medical certificate – a 10% deduction from the entry fee if withdrawal received before the draw and no refund available after the draw

## REGISTRATION:

The official registration desk will be located inside the main entrance. Competitors must check in at 4:00pm each day.

## SPECTATOR ENTRY:

\$2 per person

## MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

All participants must be **financial members** of their State Association

## PRACTICES:

Official Practices are on the morning of the event between 7:00am and 9:00am. The amount of time available for Official Practices is limited and the practice sessions will be short, generally allowing for a group warm-up and one run-through of your program. Synchronised Teams will receive 15 minutes official practice. The practice schedule will be advised a week before the event.

## MUSIC:

- must be provided on CD,
- must contain only **ONE** track,
- must be marked with:
  - competitor's name,
  - division (e.g. Junior Ladies)
  - program description (e.g. "Short Program")
  - exact running time of the music (not skating time).

Please have a spare copy at the rink in case it is needed. Solo Dance music will be provided. Aussie Skaters, please provide music of your choice.

## TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Aussie Skate as per Handbook except full ice will be available. ISA levels as specified for this season by ISA. The relevant documents can be downloaded from the SAISA website [www.saisa.org.au](http://www.saisa.org.au). Technical requirements for the Youth Divisions are the same as the equivalent Adult level technical requirements. Open Synchro is as set by ISA. Pre-Preliminary is for skaters who have completed Aussie Skate but not passed the Preliminary Test

## DETERMINATION OF RESULTS:

The ISU Judging System will be used for State Championship levels and for Preliminary, Elementary and Pre-Primary in Winter Challenge. Closed marking will be used for Aussie Skate divisions, Solo Dance, Adult and Youth and Open Synchro, using the 6.0 system

## TROPHIES:

Trophies/medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place-getters. Ribbons/medals will be awarded to 4<sup>th</sup> place onwards. Participation Certificates will be presented to all participants.

The Dejan Jovanovic Memorial Trophy and the Abram Family Cup will be awarded by the respective families

## PRESENTATIONS:

Presentations, where appropriate, will be made off-ice at the end of each day's schedule in the designated area of the coffee shop

## AFTER COMPETITION DINNER:

Group bookings will be made for skaters and families who would like to get together following the competition at the Royal Hotel, Henley Beach Road. If participants would also like group bookings for other nights of the competition that can also be arranged. See the registration desk or contact SAISA before-hand
